About:

During the Civil War, the owners of Cygnet Hollow sold pies out of their back door, a baking tradition that is still kept alive today. The farm also raises heritage breeds of chickens and keep a flock of fiber animals, and keep them all safe with flock guardian dogs. Fiber arts like spinning yarn, weaving, and felting wool are daily occurrences, and keep them busy when not playing with lambs and chicks!

Programs:

Kid-friendly animals to meet and touch. Fiber art projects for children, spinning and weaving demos, flock guardian dogs working, and sheep shearing.

Farm Sales:

Food and drinks available with seating in the shade of a 200 yr old oak tree. Baked goods, fresh eggs, and yarns available all day. Layer and heritage breed chicks/chickens and ducks/ducklings will be available.

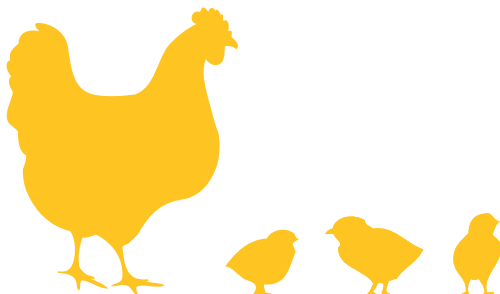
Farm Animals:

Sheep, alpacas, and angora rabbits for fiber production. Heritage breed chickens for eggs. Great Pyrenees flock guardian dogs. Horses and ponies.

Directions:

From Charlottesville - 64 East to Exit 143 Louisa/Ferncliff / North on Rt. 208 for 2.3 miles / Left on E Jack Jouett / In few hundred yards turn right on Byrd Mill Rd for 2.5 miles / Continue straight on Waldrop Church Rd for 2 miles / Turn left on Tisdale Rd, go 1 mile / Farm driveway is on left, look for balloons.
